Wed 24 Jun Weald & Downland Living Museum

Home to the popular TV series 'The Repair Shop', there is much to see and explore at this village style site including historic buildings, crafts/skills demonstrations of a bygone era, etc, and which is described as a magical place to experience rural living history.

Wed 22 July St Mary's House & Gardens, Bramber and Worthing
